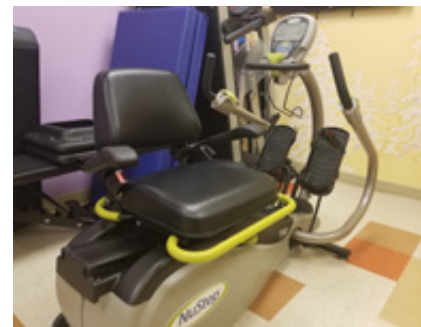


Pony Walker

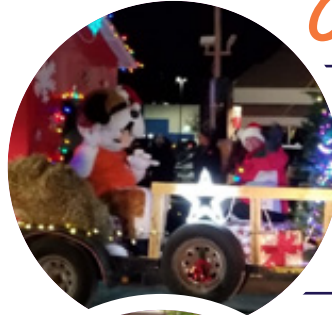
